



HOW WE WORK

When requested by a patient or a provider, Acadian Health will send a Mobile Health provider to a patient's location. Our providers can treat exacerbations of cancer-related symptoms, offer pain management, administer treatment infusions, or provide palliative and supportive care.




We ensure patients are connected to and engaged with a provider. We are able to include a member of the patient's care team via telehealth during each visit to improve relationships with providers and coordination of care.

- · Chronic Disease Exacerbation






PROGRAM BENEFITS

Acadian Health works to ensure a positive experience and outcome for your patient so they can remain at home and comfortable.


